With spatial video gaining traction (thanks Apple Vision Pro!), we're seeing new container formats emerge. But for now, MP4 remains the safe bet. Industry insiders predict HEVC will become the new H.264 by 2026 - but that's a story for another day.

## Conversion Pro Tips

- Always keep original files - storage is cheaper than reshoots
- Use hardware acceleration - cuts conversion time by half
- Check bitrate settings - 25Mbps is the sweet spot for 4K

Still getting format errors? Might be time to update your media player. VLC 4.0 (released last month) now supports 360+ formats - basically everything except your ex's mixed signals.
